- 1. Our fellow ministry leaders in South America understand the Great Commission.** The personal testimonies during the graduation were laced with stories of God’s clear call to make disciples and a commitment to return to their homes and begin joining God in this Kingdom work. God, as only He can do, had met each of them during their time at the camp in a unique way and transformed hearts. They are re-entering their ministries with a renewed clarity and passion.
